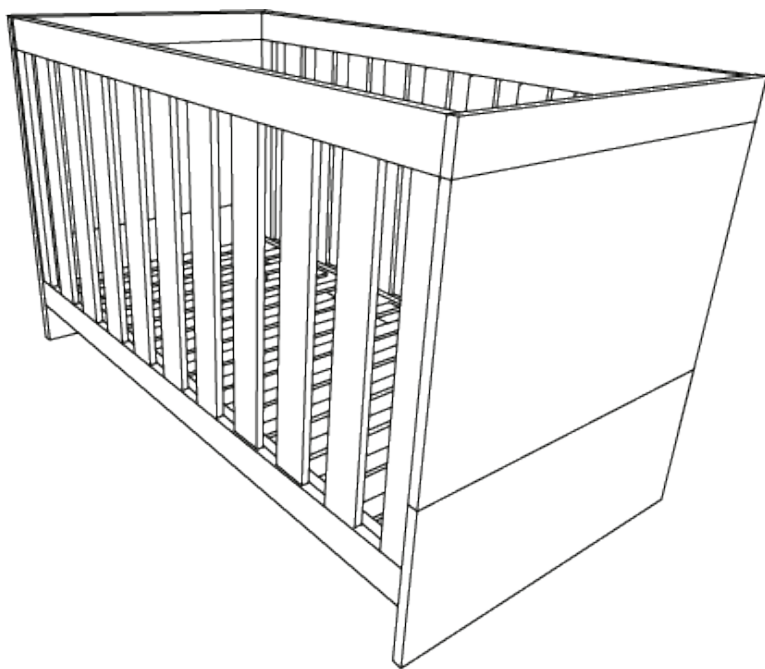

Budworth Cot Bed

Instruction Manual

Welcome

Thank you for purchasing the **Puggle Budworth Cot Bed**.

Please read these instructions and safety warnings carefully before use to ensure safe and satisfactory operation of this product.

WARNING! Assembly by an adult. Keep away from children until fully assembled. Keep children clear during assembly as pack contains small parts which may present a choking hazard.

Lay out the parts on a soft level surface and compare to the part/fixings checklist. Do not discard any packaging until you are sure that you have all the parts.

This **Cot Bed** is designed to be easily dismantled for storage or transportation.

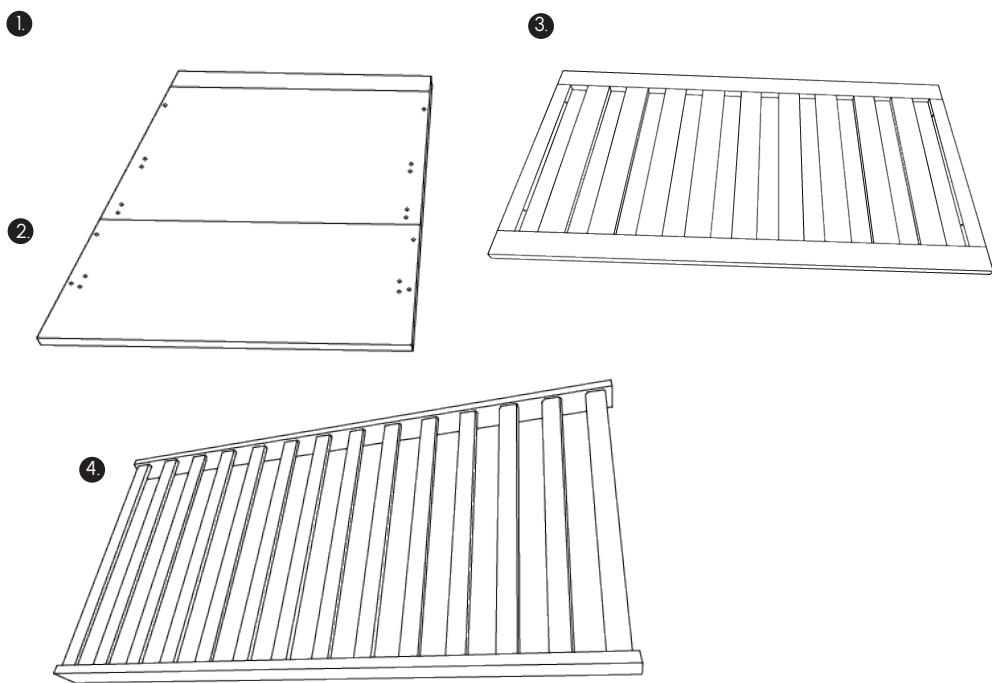

IMPORTANT – Read the instructions carefully before use and keep for future reference.

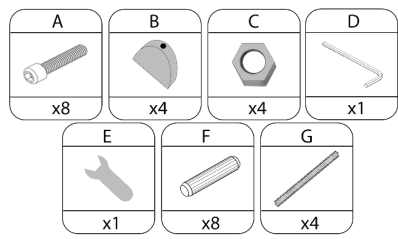
- **WARNING:** A child's safety is your responsibility.
- **WARNING:** Be aware of the risk of open fire and other sources of strong heat, such as electric bar fires, gas fires, etc. in the near vicinity of the cot.
- **WARNING:** Do not use the cot if any part is broken, torn or missing and use only additional or replacement parts obtained from the manufacturer or distributor.
- **WARNING:** Do not leave anything in the cot or place the cot close to another product, which could provide a foothold or present a danger of suffocation or strangulation, e.g. strings, blinds/curtain cords etc.
- **WARNING:** Do not use more than one mattress in the cot.
- **WARNING:** Do not place this cot bed in close proximity to heat sources, windows and other furniture e.g. open fires, radiators, gas and electric heaters etc. The lowest cot base position is the safest. The base should always be used in the lowest position as soon as the baby is old enough to sit up.
- The thickness of the mattress used shall be such that the internal height (surface of the mattress to the upper edge of the cot frame) is at least 500mm in the lowest position of the mattress base and at least 200mm in the highest position of the mattress base. Maximum thickness of 10mm.
- All assembly fittings should always be tightened properly, checked periodically and the care should be taken that no bolts are loose, because a child could trap parts of the body or clothing (e.g. strings, necklaces, ribbons for babies' dummies), which could pose a risk of suffocation and strangulation.
- The safety of the cot could be adversely affected by fitting flammable drapes.
- To prevent injury from falls, when the child is able to climb out of the cot bed, the cot bed should be converted into a toddler bed.
- Recommended mattress size is 140 x 70cm and shall be such that the gap between the mattress and the sides and ends does not exceed 30mm.
- This Puggle Cot Bed conforms to BS EN 716-1:2017 and the Toddler Bed conforms to BS 8509:2008+A1:2011.
- The Cot Bed is suitable from birth. When the cot is converted to toddler bed mode, the minimum age should not be less than 18 months and the maximum age should not be more than 4 years old.
- Children are likely to play, bounce, jump and climb on beds, therefore the child's bed should not be placed too close to other furniture or windows, blind cords, curtain pulls or other strings or cords and should be placed either tight to any wall or have a gap of 30cm between the wall and the side of the bed.

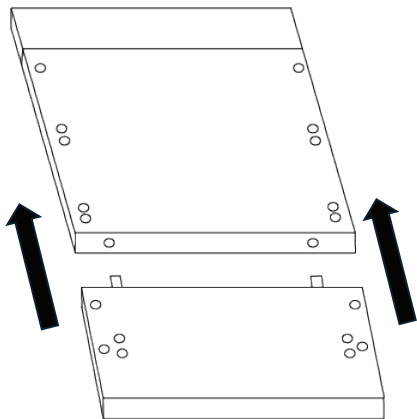

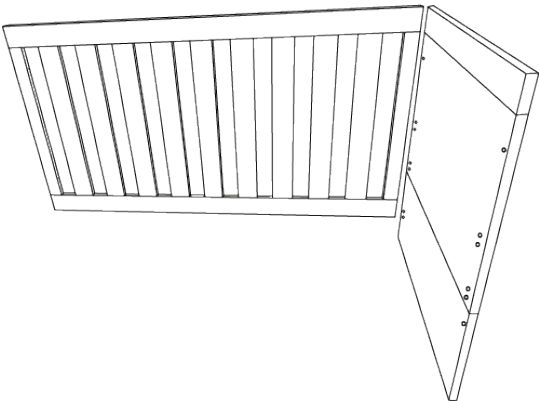
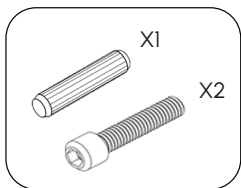

G	Metal Threaded Dowel	4



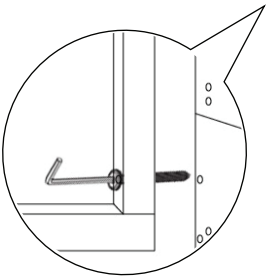
Assembling the Cot Bed



1. Slot the end panel bottom (2) into The end panel top (1).
2. Repeat this step with the remaining End panel bottom (2) and end panel Top (1).

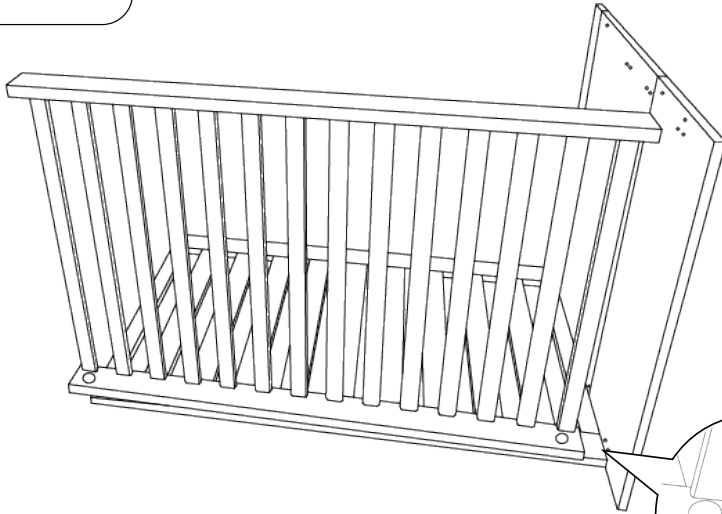
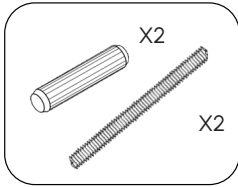


3. Attach one of the side panels (3) to one of the end panels Assembled in the previous Step using the bolt (a), Wooden dowel (f) and Tighten with the allen key (d).

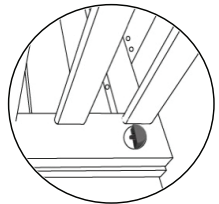


WARNING: DO NOT use power tools to tighten bolts only use the Allen Key (D) provided.

Assembling the Cot Bed

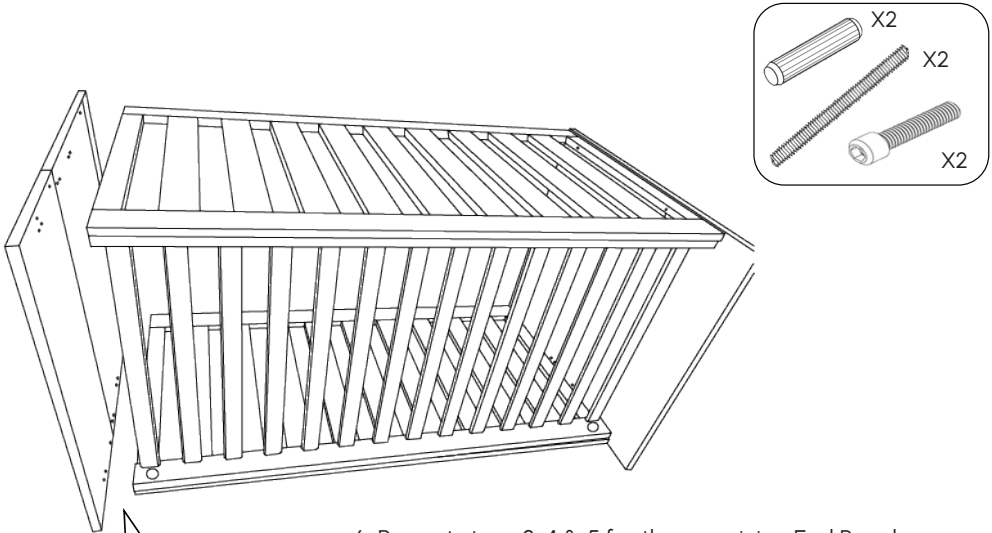


4. Align the Base Panel (4) to the End Panel using the Metal Threaded Dowel (G), Wooden Dowel (F).
5. Insert a Half Moon Nut (B) into the pre-drilled hole on the Base Panel (4) and then attach to the End Panel using a Nut (C) on the Metal Threaded Dowel (G) and tighten with the Spanner (E).



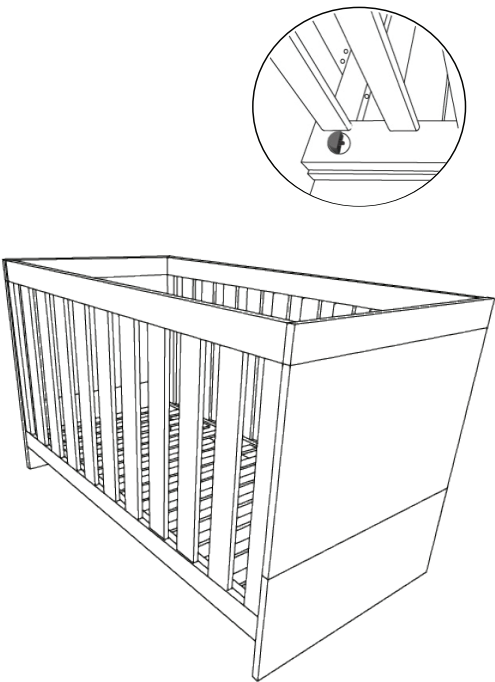
NOTE: The Base Panel (4) can be adjusted as there are 3 height settings, the above shows the lowest.

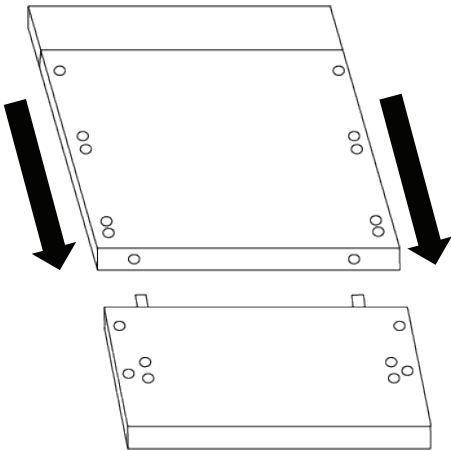


WARNING! This step requires 2 people.

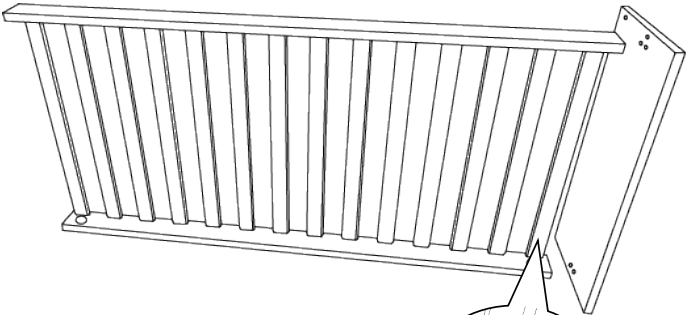
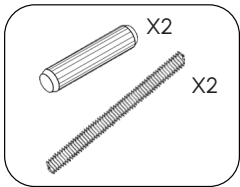
7. Turn the assembled cot bed into the upright position. The mattress can now be added and dressed as required.



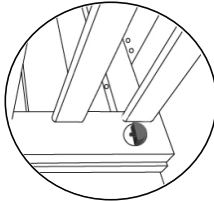
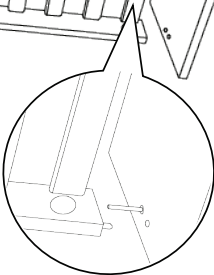
Assembling the Toddler Bed



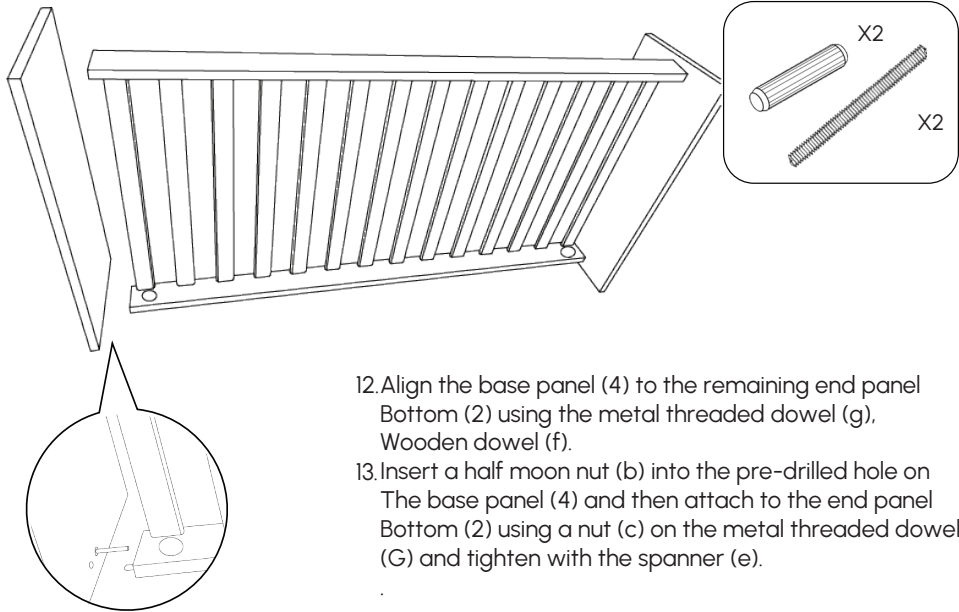
- 8. Remove the End Panel Bottom (2) from the End Panel Top (1).
- 9. Repeat this step with the remaining End Panel Bottom (2) and End Panel Top (1).



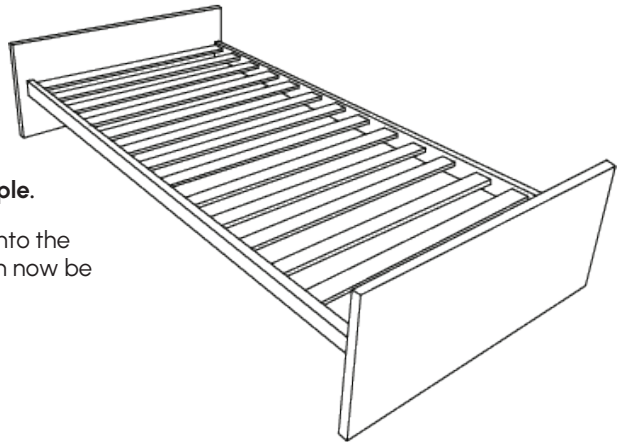
- 10. Align the base panel (4) to the end panel bottom (2) Using the metal threaded dowel (G), wooden dowel (F).
- 11. Insert a half moon nut (B) into the pre-drilled hole on The base panel (4) and then attach to the end panel Bottom (2) using a nut (C) on the metal threaded dowel (G) and tighten with the spanner (E).

12. Align the base panel (4) to the remaining end panel Bottom (2) using the metal threaded dowel (g), Wooden dowel (f).
13. Insert a half moon nut (b) into the pre-drilled hole on The base panel (4) and then attach to the end panel Bottom (2) using a nut (c) on the metal threaded dowel (G) and tighten with the spanner (e).



WARNING! This step requires 2 people.

14. Turn the assembled toddler bed into the upright position. The mattress can now be added and dressed as required.

Care and Maintenance

- Scuff marks may be removed with a soft, damp cloth.
- Occasional use of furniture polish will maintain the finish of your Cot Bed.
- DO NOT use harsh or abrasive cleaners or bleaches on this product, as they may damage the finish.
- Periodically check all fixings to ensure they remain tight and tighten where required.
