
Before Assembly

Main Components



- Unpack all the parts and identify them against the fitting and components list.

- Crosshead screwdriver (not provided).






IMPORTANT – Read the instructions carefully before use and keep for future reference.

Warning:

- Do not leave your child unattended.
- Always use the wall attachment strap provided.
- All assembly fixings should always be tightened properly. Care should be taken that no screws are loose because a child could trap parts of their body, or clothing (e.g., strings, necklaces, ribbons, dummies, etc.) which could pose a risk of strangulation.
- Be aware of the risk of open flames and other such sources of strong heat, such as electric bar fires, gas fires, etc. in the near vicinity of the dresser.
- Take care when handling or moving the furniture. Careless handling may cause damage.
- Regularly check that all fixings are tightened and that there are no broken or damaged parts

Suitable for use with a changing mat of max size 75 x 50 cm.

The changing area is suitable for use up to 12 months old or 11 kg in weight maximum.

DO NOT use the dresser if any of the parts are broken, torn or missing.

Any additional or replacement parts can only be obtained from the manufacturer or the distributor.

Ensure there are no small parts fittings are left after assembly as these can be a choking hazard.

Cleaning

Your dresser can be cleaned by wiping with a damp cloth and drying with a soft clean cloth.

Do not use abrasives, bleach, alcohol or ammonia-based household polishes.
