

Lay out the parts on a soft level surface and compare to the part/fixings checklist. Do not discard any packaging until you are sure that you have all the parts.



Before Assembly


Before starting the assembly, please read through these instructions. Then carefully unpack your cotbed and check that you have a complete set of parts against the list. We advise that the cotbed should be assembled in the room where it is intended to be used by two adults. The cotbed should be assembled on a clean, flat surface, making sure there are no sharp objects present that could mark or damage the panels.



There are many small components used in the construction of this cotbed. These items should be kept out of reach of young children whilst assembling the unit.






Safety Instructions

IMPORTANT – Read the instructions carefully before use and keep for future reference.

Safety:

- Always use the wall attachment strap provided.
- All assembly fixings should always be tightened properly. Care should be taken that no screws are loose because a child could trap parts of their body, or clothing (e.g. strings, necklaces, ribbons, dummies, etc.) which could pose a risk of strangulation.
- Be aware of the risks of open fires and other such sources of strong heat, such as electric bar fires, gas fires, etc. in the near vicinity of the wardrobe.
- Do not use if any of the parts are broken, torn or missing.
- Any additional or replacement parts can only be obtained from the manufacturer or the distributor.
- Ensure there are no small parts fittings are left after assembly as they can be a choking hazard.

Warnings

- Take care when handling or moving the furniture. Careless handling may cause damage.
- Regularly check that all fixings are tightened and that there are no broken or damaged parts.

Cleaning

- Your wardrobe can be cleaned by wiping with a damp cloth and drying with a soft clean cloth.
- Do not use abrasives, bleach, alcohol or ammonia-based household polishes.
