

Instruction Manual

Welcome

Thank you for purchasing the **Puggle Mayfair Cot Bed**.

Please read these instructions and safety warnings carefully before use to ensure safe and satisfactory operation of this product.

WARNING! Assembly by an adult. Keep away from children until fully assembled. Keep children clear during assembly as pack contains small parts which may present a choking hazard.

Lay out the parts on a soft level surface and compare to the part/fixings checklist. Do not discard any packaging until you are sure that you have all the parts.

This **Cot Bed** is designed to be easily dismantled for storage or transportation.

Safety Instructions

IMPORTANT – Read the instructions carefully before use and keep for future reference.


- **WARNING:** A child's safety is your responsibility.
- **WARNING:** Be aware of the risk of open fire and other sources of strong heat, such as electric bar fires, gas fires, etc. in the near vicinity of the cot.
- **WARNING:** Do not use the cot if any part is broken, torn or missing and use only additional or replacement parts obtained from the manufacturer or distributor.
- **WARNING:** Do not leave anything in the cot or place the cot close to another product, which could provide a foothold or present a danger of suffocation or strangulation, e.g. strings, blinds/curtain cords etc.
- **WARNING:** Do not use more than one mattress in the cot.
- **WARNING:** Do not place this cot bed in close proximity to heat sources, windows and other furniture e.g. open fires, radiators, gas and electric heaters etc. The lowest cot base position is the safest. The base should always be used in the lowest position as soon as the baby is old enough to sit up.
- The thickness of the mattress used shall be such that the internal height (surface of the mattress to the upper edge of the cot frame) is at least 500mm in the lowest position of the mattress base and at least 200mm in the highest position of the mattress base. Maximum thickness of 10mm.
- All assembly fittings should always be tightened properly, checked periodically and the care should be taken that no bolts are loose, because a child could trap parts of the body or clothing (e.g. strings, necklaces, ribbons for babies' dummies), which could pose a risk of suffocation and strangulation.
- The safety of the cot could be adversely affected by fitting flammable drapes.
- To prevent injury from falls, when the child is able to climb out of the cot bed, the cot bed should be converted into a toddler bed.
- Recommended mattress size is 140 x 70cm and shall be such that the gap between the mattress and the sides and ends does not exceed 30mm.
- This Puggle Cot Bed conforms to BS EN 716-1:2017 and the Toddler Bed conforms to BS 8509:2008+A1:2011.
- The Cot Bed is suitable from birth. When the cot is converted to toddler bed mode, the minimum age should not be less than 18 months and the maximum age should not be more than 4 years old.
- Children are likely to play, bounce, jump and climb on beds, therefore the child's bed should not be placed too close to other furniture or windows, blind cords, curtain pulls or other strings or cords and should be placed either tight to any wall or have a gap of 30cm between the wall and the side of the bed.

Before Assembly

Before starting the assembly, please read through these instructions. Then carefully unpack your cotbed and check that you have a complete set of parts against the list. We advise that the cotbed should be assembled in the room where it is intended to be used by two adults. The cotbed should be assembled on a clean, flat surface, making sure there are no sharp objects present that could mark or damage the panels.

CAUTION:


There are many small components used in the construction of this cotbed. These items should be kept out of reach of young children whilst assembling the unit.
