

Your Sleepy Rocking Bedside Crib is tested to comply with EN 1130:2019 and EN 16890:2017.

- DO NOT use parts or accessories which are not approved or supplied by the manufacturer.
- DO NOT allow your child to play with this product without adult supervision.

Safety Instructions

IMPORTANT - Read the instructions carefully before use and keep for future reference.

- WARNING: A child's safety is your responsibility, never leave the child unattended.
- **WARNING:** before use, remove and dispose of all plastic bags and packaging materials and keep out of reach of children.
- **WARNING:** Before assembly, check that the product and all of its components have not been damaged during transportation. Should any part be damaged, do not use and keep out of reach of children.
- **WARNING:** Adult assembly is required.
- **WARNING:** make sure the users of this product are knowledgeable on its proper operation.
- **WARNING:** DO NOT allow other children to play unattended near the crib. Sleepy Rocking Bedside Crib

Warnings

- **WARNING:** This product is suitable for use by one child at a time only.
- **WARNING:** This product is intended for use for babies aged between 0 and 6 months, weighing up to a maximum of 9kg.
- **WARNING:** When a child is able to sit, kneel or to pull itself up, the crib shall not be used anymore for this child.
- **WARNING:** Only use the mattress sold with this crib. DO NOT add a second mattress on top of this one suffocation hazards.
- **WARNING:** DO NOT use more than one mattress in the product.
- **WARNING:** Be aware of the risk of burning cigarettes, open fires and other sources of strong heat, such as electric bar fires, gas fires etc. near the crib.
- WARNING: DO NOT place the product close to another product, which could present a danger of suffocation or strangulation, e.g. strings, blind/curtain cords etc.
- When not in use, the crib must be kept out of the reach of children.
- **WARNING:** Make sure the users of this product are knowledgeable on its proper operation.
- **WARNING:** The product is ready for use only when all locking mechanisms are engaged. Check carefully that these are engaged before use.
- **WARNING:** Placing additional items in the product may cause suffocation.
- WARNING: Always ensure that the rocker feet are folded when a child is unsupervised.
- All opening, adjusting, anchoring and positioning operations of the product must be carried out exclusively by an adult.
- The product must always be placed on a horizontal surface. Never leave the product on an inclined surface with the child inside of it.
- **WARNING:** DO NOT use the product without the frame.
- The mattress length and width shall be such that the maximum gap between the mattress and crib sides and ends does not exceed 30mm.
- Mattress size: 360 x 200 x 30 mm.
- The thickness of the mattress must be such that the vertical height (upper surface of the mattress until the upper edge of the product's sides) is at least 200mm.
- The reference mark on the product's interior indicates the maximum thickness of the mattress that shall be used.
- DO NOT leave any object inside the product that could reduce its depth.
- DO NOT position the product near walls and obstacles to prevent trapping hazards.
- DO NOT leave small objects inside the product to prevent choking hazards.
- DO NOT adjust the product with the child inside.
- DO NOT move the product with the child inside.
- The product must be kept away from electric cables and cords: do not place the product near windows where cords, curtains or similar objects could pose choking or strangulation hazards

Warnings

for the child. To avoid strangulation hazards, do not give to your child or place near her/him, objects equipped with cords.

- **WARNING:** DO NOT use the product if any part is broken, torn or missing. Contact thenurserystore.com/contact-us for replacement parts and instructional literature
- DO NOT use accessories or replacement parts other than those approved by the manufacturer.

Before assembly, please ensure that you have read and understood the instructions. Then carefully unpack your crib and ensure that all parts are present, please see parts list as follows.






Discard packaging in accordance with your local authority guidelines.

Assembling the Sleepy Rocking Crib

1. Unfold the Main Body (A) as shown in the below left image, when fully unfolded it will click into place as shown in the below right image.




2. Insert the Legs (C) into the Main Body (A) as per the below left image. When fully inserted the Legs (C) should click into place and the spring pin will pop out of the corresponding hole on the Main Body (A) as shown in the below right image.




Assembling the Sleepy Rocking Crib

3. Insert the Mattress (B) into the Main Body (A), as per the below images. Ensure that the mattress is as far down into the Main Body (A) as possible and there are no objects placed within the Main Body (A) that could reduce it's depth.




4. For "rocking mode", simply press the button on the centre of the feet on the Legs (C) as shown by the arrow below and then fold in. The Legs (C) will click into indicate locked in place and then the crib will gently rock on the curved bar on the Legs (C) as shown below right.

5. To fold the Sleepy Rocking Crib, ensure that the feet on the Legs (C) are in "crib mode" and remove the mattress and fold in half to be stored away. Then using the fabric tab push down and pull up, the Main Body (A) will then fold as shown below.



Care and Maintenance

Care and Maintenance

Cleaning

- Clean the plastic parts with a soft damp cloth.
- DO NOT use harsh or abrasive cleaners or bleaches on this product, as they may damage the product.
- If the rocking crib comes into contact with water, dry the metal parts to prevent the formation of rust.

Maintenance

- Cleaning and maintenance should be carried out by an adult, do not allow a child to do this unless supervised and correct instruction has been provided.
- Periodically check all fixings to ensure they remain tight and tighten where required.
- DO NOT use this product if any part is broken, torn or missing and use only spares provided by the manufacturer.
- If parts become stiff or difficult to operate, ensure dirt is not the cause, then try a light application of a silicon lubricant, ensuring it penetrates between the components. Regular lubrication of moving parts will extend the life of your product and make opening and folding easier.
- After exposure to damp conditions, dry off with a soft cloth and leave fully open in a warm environment. Storing damp will encourage mildew to form.
- Store in a dry place.
- DO NOT leave in sunlight for prolonged periods as some colours may fade.
